Objectives

- To develop and encourage parental engagement and provide parent/pupil learning opportunities
- To ensure consistently high attendance, engagement and achievement
- To ensure nurture support for vulnerable pupils
- To develop additional teaching and learning spaces for one to one and group work
- To ensure that safeguarding practice is effective and efficient

Summary of spending and actions taken

- Contract/cost of Tipton Learning Community EWO
 - Attendance meetings
 - Home visits
- Contract/cost of Parent Support Advisor
- Split funding/contract for Lead Safeguarding Officer for Tipton Learning Community
- Funding for FSM pupils to access Breakfast Club
- Bug Club online reading scheme – personal log in and home access for pupils
- Funding towards additional learning spaces/resources
- Funding of parent/pupil learn2gether sessions

Outcomes

- Attendance at 96.1 (FSM attendance risen from 93.1 to 95% over three years)
- Attendance meetings /letters in place for 90% attenders/contracts etc
- Parent group coffee mornings/afternoons – pupil and parent sessions
- All pupils logged into BugClub online
- Fortnightly safeguarding review meetings
